I Sverige bland annat på Moderna Museet, Malmö; Malmö Konsthall; Malmö Konstmuseum; Nordiska Akvarellmuseet, Skärhamn; Nässjö Konsthall; Göteborgs Konsthall; Borås Konstmuseum och Island of Light, Smögen samt Konsthallen på Bohusläns museum. Monumental projection

In a troubled time of inhuman suffering, war and violence,
perhaps we want to see a glimmer of light in the darkness?

Lena Mattsson's new works are filmed and edited to be projected onto a boathouse on Smögen's jetty, where they interact with the unique environment and its historical context with sharp precision. We get to enter as visitors into a magical world, a realization of the place's own poetry. There, past, present, dream and reality are woven together. In war and love, everything is supposed to be allowed, so perhaps also these revelations of boundlessness in time and space?

The music is specially composed by the multifaceted Conny C-A Malmqvist, who, in addition to being a writer and philosopher, also regularly creates the sound visions that accompany Lena Mattsson's imagery. The work is dedicated to all residents and visitors to this magical island. Lena Mattsson herself grew up in the area and is inspired by the place and its surroundings, which have deeply influenced her artistry.

Lena Mattsson was born in Kungshamn in 1966 and works in Malmö.

Lena Mattsson – Unexpected Visit
The Art Gallery at Bohusläns Museum
11.11 2023 - 17.12 2023

Lena Mattsson mainly works with video and film, where she portrays everyday situations that are transformed, and which ultimately make us think about deeper questions in our existence. The film triptych *Unexpected Visit* is shown in the exhibition.

Lena Mattsson is interested in how our perception relates to being, time and space. With a poetic and sensitive visual language, she touches on existential themes in our lives. A magical realism appears in the works, the seemingly obvious takes on another dimension and the works are filled with a deeper symbolism. The contrast between the obvious and a deeper meaning creates a duality between surface and depth that gives tension to her work.

Unexpected Visit

In the film triptych *Unexpected Visit*, we see how a child/young person climbs up and down a ladder. The symbolism surrounding the ladder is complex and can be interpreted in many different ways and shows all the changes in life, how the child grows up, develops and is socialized into society and perhaps climbs up the social ladder, and then goes down again. The descent means the opposite and that you have to start all over again – the pendulum swings.

In several religions, the steps are mainly depicted as a transition between earthly life and the spiritual. In her films, Lena Mattsson often works metaphorically and adds different layers of film. In the triptych *Unexpected Visit*, we can see pictures and environments from Lena's childhood home in Kungshamn as well as other well-known places in Bohuslän, such as Hovenäset, Bohus-Malmö and Smögen. We can also see Lena Mattsson's grandfather peeking past. The work can be seen as a metaphorical and poetic journey in past and present. The music for the video work was created by Conny C-A Malmqvist.

Another Brick in the Wall

Outside on the museum facade, the work *Another Brick in the Wall* is projected, which can be seen during the dark hours of the day. The work depicts a crying woman, where the tears seem to turn into something else? The scene is repeated at a fast pace and refers to the vulnerability of women worldwide. There, feelings are expressed that deal with oppression, lack of freedom and even tenderness, but also a sadness about the situation in the world. Lena Mattsson's work opens up simultaneous events in interior and exterior spaces in both the past and present. Also in this work, the music was created by Conny C-A Malmqvist.

About the artist

Lena Mattsson was born in Kungshamn in 1966 and works in Malmö. She is primarily a video and performance artist, but began her career as a painter. She is also active as a curator for contemporary art. Mattsson's own works often refer to art history and film and are in an intense conversation with both the present and history.

She is educated at Målarskolan Forum, now Malmö Art Academy and has shown her works, films and video installations at a number of exhibitions around Sweden and the world, including at the Moderna Museet Malmö, Malmö Konsthall, Malmö Art Museum, Nordic Watercolor Museum, Skärhamn, Nässjö Konsthall, Göteborgs Konsthall, Borås Museum of Modern Art and Island of Light, Smögen and The Art

Gallery at Bohusläns Museum, Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, Denmark, Museum of Contemporary Art, Santiago, Chile, Stedelijk Museum, Amsterdam, Netherlands, Museum for Contemporary Art, Roskilde, Denmark, National Art Gallery Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, Metropolitan Art Museum, Pusan, South Korea and many more.

Lena Mattsson – Unexpected Visit

Lena Mattsson arbetar främst med video och film, där hon gestaltar vardagliga situationer som omformas och som slutligen får att oss fundera över djupare frågeställningar i vår tillvaro. I utställningen visas filmtriptyken Unexpected Visit.

Lena Mattsson intresserar sig för hur vår perception förhåller sig till varande, tid och rum. Med ett poetisk och känsligt bildspråk berör hon existentiella teman i våra liv. En magisk realism framträder i verken, det till synes uppenbara får en annan dimension och verken fylls av en djupare symbolik. Kontrasten mellan det uppenbara och en djupare innebörd skapar en dualitet mellan yta och djup som ger en spänning i hennes verk.

Unexpected Visit

I filmtriptyken *Unexpected Visit* ser vi hur ett barn/en ung person klättrar upp och ned för en stegen. Symboliken kring stegen är komplex och kan tolkas på många olika sätt och visar på livets alla skiften, hur barnet växer upp, utvecklas och socialiseras in i samhället och kanske klättrar uppåt för samhällsstegen, för att sedan gå ner igen. Nedstigningen betyder det motsatta och att man måste börja om igen – pendeln svänger.

Inom flera religioner återges stegen främst som en övergång mellan det jordiska livet och det andliga. I sina filmer arbetar Lena Mattsson ofta metaforiskt och lägger in olika lager av film. I triptyken *Unexpected Visit* kan vi se bilder och miljöer från Lenas barndomshem i Kungshamn samt andra välkända bohuslänska platser, som till exempel Hovenäset, Bohus-Malmön och Smögen. Vi kan även se även Lena Mattssons morfar skymta förbi. Verket kan ses som en metaforisk och poetisk resa i dåtid och nutid. Musiken till videoverket är skapad av Conny C-A Malmqvist.

Another Brick in the Wall

Utanför på museet fasad projiceras verket *Another Brick in the Wall* som kan ses under dygnets mörka timmar. Verket föreställer en gråtande kvinna, där tårarna tycks övergå i någonting annat? Scenen återupprepas i ett snabbt tempo och syftar på kvinnors utsatthet världen över. Där uttrycks känslor som handlar om förtryck, ofrihet och även ömhet, men också en sorg över situationen i världen. Lena Mattssons verk öppnar upp för simultana skeenden i inre och yttre rum i både dåtid och nutid. Även i detta verk är musiken skapad av Conny C-A Malmqvist.

Om konstnären

Lena Mattsson är född i Kungshamn 1966 och är verksam i Malmö. Hon är främst video- och performancekonstnär, men började sin bana som målare. Hon är också verksam som curator för samtidskonst. Mattssons egna verk refererar ofta till konsthistoria och film och befinner sig i ett intensivt samtal med både nuet och historien.

Hon är utbildad vid Målarskolan Forum, numera Konsthögskolan i Malmö och har visat sina verk, filmer och videoinstallationer på en rad utställningar runtom i Sverige och världen, bland annat på Moderna Museet i Malmö, Malmö Konsthall, Malmö Konstmuseum, Nordiska Akvarellmuseet, Skärhamn, Nässjö Konsthall, Göteborgs Konsthall, Borås Konstmuseum och Island of Light, Smögen samt Konsthallen på Bohusläns museum, Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, Danmark, Museum of Contemporary Art, Santiago, Chile, Stedelijk Museum, Amsterdam, Nederländerna, Museum for Contemporary Art, Roskilde, Danmark, National Art Gallery Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, Metropolitan Art Museum, Pusan, Sydkorea och många fler.

Gone Fishing Roots

Lena Mattsson intresserar sig för människans relation till och perception av omvärlden, tid och rum. Hon utgår ofta från till synes vardagliga situationer som längs vägen förskjuts och får oss att ifrågasätta tillvarons grundvalar. Hon leker ofta med skala i sina verk och hennes verk framträder på oväntade men skraddarsydd platser. Mattssons verk *Gone Fishing* föreställer ett fiskande barn som drar upp objekt ur vattnet och verket belyser frågor om miljöförstöring och människans syn på naturen. Det som dras upp från botten av vattnet väver oss också samman med föregående generationer, med människors kollektiva varande och beteenden och når in till frågor om vårt eget inre djup. Inne i museet ställs besökaren inför en tillsynes ömsint gestalt som framkallar tankar om ett sorts naturväsen. På en trädrot blåser ett barn ut och återaktiverar ett ljus i en cykel som slår an till årsringarnas form och tidens sammanlänkande loop.

Verket **Roots** förhåller sig till rötter såväl rent fysiskt som på ett metaforiskt plan. Hela installationen skapar dubbelbottnade associationer och visar på något sätt hur allt hänger ihop - början, slutet, evigheten. Verken som gestaltas ute och inne länkas samman innehållsmässigt och kan läsas som en triptyk. Mattsson är skicklig på att skapa stämningar och tar med oss på en resa där vi slungas mellan spänning, sensibilitet, magi, realism och symboliska undertoner. Verkens tillhörande musik är skapad av Conny C-A Malmkvist, musiker, konstkritiker och filosof.

Lena Mattsson (f.1966) bor och verkar i Malmö. Hon är utbildad vid Målarskolan Forum nu (Konsthögskolan i Malmö, Sverige). Mattsson har visat sina verk, filmer och videoinstallationer på en rad utställningar runtom i världen. I Sverige bland annat Moderna Museet Malmö, Malmö Konsthall, Malmö Konstmuseum, Nordiska Akvarellmuseet, Skärhamn, Nässjö Konsthall, Göteborgs Konsthall och Island of Light, Smögen. Urval av utställningar utomlands är Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, Danmark; Museum of Contemporary Art, Santiago, Chile; Stedelijk Museum, Amsterdam, Holland; National Art Gallery, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia; Metropolitan Art Museum, Pusan, South Korea; SPARK VIDEO: BEACON New York, USA; Portobello Film Festival, London, England. Hon har tilldelats priser från exempelvis The Edstrand Foundation Art Prize och Konstnärsnämndens 10-åriga stipendium. Mattsson är även verksam som curator och curaterade tillsammans med Ola Åstrand *Generation – En spegling av 1990-talets konstscen* och *Kultur under Covid-19* på Borås Konstmuseum (2020-2021).

ENGLISH:

Lena Mattsson explores how we relate to and perceive the world, time and space, often basing her work on seemingly ordinary situations that gradually shift and prompt us to question the fundamentals of life. She often plays with scale, and her works appear in surprising yet tailored places. **Gone Fishing** features children who fish objects out of the water; the work addresses environmental pollution and our attitude to nature. The stuff pulled up from the seabed also intimately connects us to previous generations, people's collective lives and actions, and touches on questions in our own inner depths. Inside the museum, visitors are faced with an apparently tender figure that resembles some kind of elemental being. On a tree root, a child blows out and ignites a light in a cycle that alludes to the shape of growth rings and time's unbroken loop.

Roots relates both physically and metaphorically to roots. The installation as a whole triggers ambiguous associations and shows how everything is connected – the beginning, the end, eternity. The works, both outdoors and indoors, are connected thematically and can be read as a triptych. Mattsson is deft at conjuring up moods, and takes us on a journey that is alternately thrilling, sensitive, magical, realistic and symbolic. The accompanying music is composed by the musician, art critic and philosopher Conny C-A Malmkvist.

Lena Mattsson (b. 1966) lives and works in Malmö. She studied at Målarskolan Forum (now Malmö Art Academy) in Sweden. Mattsson's works, films and video installations have been exhibited in Sweden and internationally. Swedish exhibitions include Moderna Museet Malmö, Malmö Konsthall, Malmö Konstmuseum, the Nordic Watercolour Museum in Skärhamn, Nässjö Konsthall, Göteborgs Konsthall and Island of Light, Smögen. Selected exhibitions abroad are Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, Denmark; Museum of Contemporary Art, Santiago, Chile; Stedelijk Museum, Amsterdam, the Netherlands; the National Art Gallery, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia; The Metropolitan Art Museum, Pusan, South Korea; SPARK VIDEO: BEACON New York, USA; and the Portobello Film Festival, London, UK. She has also won art prizes and grants, including the Edstrand Foundation Art Prize and the Swedish Arts Grants Committee's ten-year grant. Mattsson works as a curator, and she and Ola Åstrand co-curated *Generation – En spegling av 1990-talets konstscen* (Generation – A Reflection on the 1990s Art Scene) and *Kultur under Covid-19* (Culture Under Covid-19) at Borås Museum of Modern Art in 2020-2021.

"Escape the nightmare" and "Unexpected visit" by Lena Mattsson In a dystopian time of war, violence and pandemic we might try to find our way back to our origins. For me personally this means Kungshamn in the region Bohuslän, where my granite-clad roots reside. The stormy sea, the red granite cliffs and the people there have shaped me. Usually we strive to move forwards, and we all dream of a better world. In my works I examine where we go when the movement gets cut off and we seem to get caught up in an endless loop. They can be seen as an invocation, a purification, an endless climbing on life's metaphorical wobbly ladder where the present, the past and man's internal psychological drama is being penetrated. We are always somewhere between beginning and end, between the water and the sky; the drama becomes vertical instead of horizontal. The ladder is also that of Jacob, where we meet the unknown which perhaps also on some level is the familiar.

In focus is also the matter of environment and the magic of nature. We are in a field of tension between on the one hand the littering, poisoning and destruction; and on the other hand the breeding, life-affirming and magical – on an inner as well as an outer plane. It is my hope that my works can be seen as personal as well as universal.

Lena Mattsson: *Den kulturelle onanisten*

Lena Mattssons film *Den kulturelle onanisten* handlar om den legendariske bokförläggaren och kulturaktivisten Bo Cavefors, som sent i livet definierade sig själv som en kulturell onanist, en som bara gör det han själv vill för att det tillfredsställer honom. Det är en beskrivning som säkert ägde giltighet för Bo Cavefors själv, men som ändå är falsk. Allt det han gjorde för sig själv fick också värde för andra, från bokutgivning till teaterproduktion och skriftställningar. Det var fruktbart för oss runt omkring honom: läsarna, vännerna, publiken. I filmen berättar han om sitt liv och sitt förlag och diskuterar med Lena Mattsson om den kulturella censuren under senare år, något både han och Lena varit utsatta för. I Bos fall rörde det sig dels om en utställning i Umeå som ställdes in av lokalpolitikerna på grund av för mycket nakenhet, om en serie nedstängningar av hans Facebook-sida av samma skäl, samt det kanske mest kända fallet när polisen hösten 1979 grep honom och vände uppochner på hans förlag i Lund för att hitta spår som kunde binda honom vid den för tiden mycket kända och fruktade västtyska terroristgruppen Rote Armee Fraktion, under ledning av den före detta journalisten Ulrike Meinhof. Bo hade gett ut en bok om Meinhof och en antologi med texter av RAF, något han inte hade gjort någon hemlighet av, men länsåklagaren var övertygad om att det fanns mer att hämta. Det fanns det dock inte och Bo frikändes och kunde återvända till sitt hem i Ballingslöv. Men hans förlag var krossat. I filmens samtal filosoferar Bo Cavefors om sitt liv, från barndom till det åldrande han vemodigt accepterade, med Lena Mattsson diskuterar han censuren med nedslag i de nämnda fallen, men också som något mer generellt. Han drar upp linjerna för en förståelse av en censurs logik som börjar med att tysta de svagaste rösterna, konstnärerna, och sedan kan gå vidare. Mot bakgrund av allt det han utsatts för är han ändå hoppfull och berättar om en gåtfull incident han var med om när hans släppts ur häktet, när en okänd människa kom om natten och frågade om han behövde hjälp. "Det finns alltid någon där ute som är beredd att hjälpa en" säger Bo och hans ögon tåras då, precis som filmrutan som översköljs av regndroppar. Det är något annat än kulturell onani.

What happens when we look at an art collection from a queer perspective? In the exhibition *(in) visible* explored this.

During the summer, you can experience three works from Malmö Art Museum's exhibition *(in) visible* at Malmö City Archives. It is Axel Karlsson Rixon's photo series *Tourism*, a digital work by Lena Mattsson, and porcelain objects by Matts Leiderstam.

The works are shown at the City Archives as part of the large exhibition that is taking place at Malmö Art Museum 12 Jun 2021 - 9 Jan 2022.

The Art Museum shows the largest part of the exhibition, which is based on the collection and presents works of art from the early 20th century to the present that raise questions about fragmentation, spaciousness, body and desire. The collection's gaps have been filled with deposits and new purchases. In collaboration with RFSL's archives and Malmö City Archives, various types of material are displayed that reflect LGBTQI + stories connected to the city in one of the rooms in the exhibition.

The exhibition is part of Öppna Malmö - the city's work to raise issues of discrimination and racism, as well as WorldPride Malmö and Copenhagen 2021.

Breakfast for Everybody, 1997
Lena Mattsson

Lena Mattsson studied at the KV Konstskola in Gothenburg and Malmö Målarskola Forum, but she is best known for her video works and performance art. In the course of her career, she has also curated exhibitions and major film projects in collaboration with other celebrities, including Bo Cavefors and Ola Åstrand. Regardless of artistic medium, Mattsson's works often refer explicitly to art and film history.

In *Breakfast for Everybody*, she paraphrases Edouard Manet's painting *Déjeuner sur l'herbe* (*The Luncheon on the Grass*) from 1863. Mattsson has used Manet's painting as a starting point, a matrix, but altered the context and situation.

The nude women in Manet's work are replaced with nude men, and the women are fully dressed. The camera in the video work is static, and the "painting" takes place in the front of it. In this way Mattsson challenges gender roles, norms and power structures in the past and present.

Under sommaren kan du uppleva tre verk ur Malmö Konstmuseums utställning *(in)visible* på Malmö Stadsarkiv. Det är Axel Karlsson Rixons fotoserie *Turism*, ett digitalt verk av Lena Mattsson, och porslinsobjekt av Matts Leiderstam.

Verken visas på Stadsarkivet som en del av den stora utställningen som pågår på Malmö Konstmuseum 12 jun 2021 - 9 jan 2022.

På Konstmuseet visas den större delen av utställningen som bygger på samlingen och presenterar konstverk från tidigt 1900-tal till nutid som väcker frågor om fragmentering, rumslighet, kropp och begär. Samlingens luckor har fyllts med inlån och nyinköp. I samarbete med RFSL:s arkiv och Malmö Stadsarkiv visas olika slags material som speglar hbtqi+-berättelser med koppling till staden i ett utav rummen i utställningen.

Utställningen är en del av Öppna Malmö - stadens arbete för att lyfta frågor om diskriminering och rasism, samt WorldPride Malmö och Köpenhamn 2021.

Lena Mattsson (*1966)
Breakfast for Everybody, 1997

Lena Mattsson är utbildad både på KV Konstskola i Göteborg och Malmö Målarskola Forum, men är främst känd för sina videoverk och performancekonst. Under sin karriär har hon även arbetat med att curaterat utställningar och större filmprojekt i samarbete med andra kulturpersonligheter, som Bo Cavefors och Ola Åstrand. I Mattssons verk, oavsett konstnärlig uttrycksform, återfinns ofta tydliga referenser till konst- och filmhistoria.

I verket *Breakfast for Everybody* refererar hon till Édouard Manets målning *Le Déjeuner sur l'herbe* (*Frukost i det gröna*) från 1863. Mattsson har använt Manets tavla som en utgångspunkt, en mall, men ändrat kontexten och förutsättningarna. De nakna kvinnorna i Manets verk blir i Mattssons verk nakna män, och istället är det kvinnorna som är påklädda. Kameran i videoverket är stillastående och "målningen" utspelar sig framför den. På så sätt ifrågasätter Mattsson könsroller, normer och maktförhållanden, både historiskt och i samtiden.

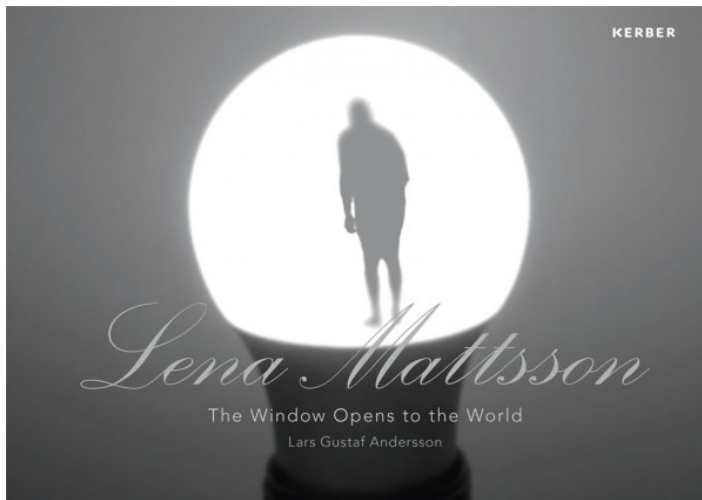

To capture movement is indeed one of the greatest challenges in visual art. Throughout the ages, artists have tried to do this in a variety of ways. Sometimes, it is a matter of capturing a fleeting moment with veritably scientific precision. At others, the situation is governed by inventiveness and a feel for the material. Sometimes, we see traces of the artist's movements, even though the work itself is static. The Swedish artist Birgit Broms was phenomenal at capturing movement in her pictures. In connection with the exhibition, we are presenting a rich array of works selected from the Museum's collection, where *In Motion* is the theme in various ways. Regardless of the tempo in the sequence, moving images are essential to the video works shown here. But motion is also a vital element in watercolour technique. Pigments colour the spreading water. Together, they pursue their precarious voyage through the sheet of paper, blending, blossoming. The brush wanders over the empty surface, filling it with events and moods. The hand turns a page, and the story continues. The images are frozen, yet in motion.

Moderna Museet Malmö is showing Lena Mattsson's video triptych In the Eye of the Beholder, about Swedish publisher and author Bo Cavefors.

In the Eye of the Beholder was originally made for the exhibition I Want to Hold Your Hand at the Borås Museum of Modern Art. The exhibition presented thirty or so Swedish artists that had been inspired by different kinds of rock music. Lena Mattsson interpreted it: "Bo Cavefors is, in spite of his claim of being totally unmusical and belonging to another cultural field, a person who, as we say in Skåne, rockar fett (totally rocks)!"

In the film Mattsson is examining the rock'n'roll myth: "All three video pieces are synchronized to a surreal rock'n'roll video triptych that envelops the viewer and both visualizes and illuminates the myth" The exhibition opens Saturday, January 18th at 4 pm by a speech by museum director John Peter Nilsson and shortly thereafter an artist talk between Lena Mattsson and Bo Cavefors will take place in the cafe at Moderna Museet Malmö.
